9. 4, 6, professional, Augustinian, 10 – vespers, compline, nocturnes, vigils matins, lauds, prime, terce, sext, none
10. a. Matins – technically at midnight, anytime in the morning b. Vespers – end of work day, 3 p.m. c. Compline – bedtime

12. church and world – bishop, pastors, ill, leaders, tragedy, poor, etc.
